# WHITE WINES

## 16. Palio Pecorino Terre di Chieti (Abruzzo, Italy)

£29.95

Fragrant, floral and pleasantly fruity, with hints of garden sage, acacia and exotic fruit. It's very fresh and juicy with exotic fruit and balsamic notes on the finish

## 17. Krall Bay Chenin Blanc (Swartland, South Africa)

£25.50

Expect a crisp white with good length, green fruit flavours, nectarine hints and a nice minerality

## 18. Gavi La Battistina (Piemonte, Italy)

£31.50

Zesty nose with apple and pears, lime and passionfruit, and a hint of minerality. Juicy, weighty fruit with a zippy, mouthwatering feel creating a refreshing, satisfying finish

## 19. Le Beau Flamant Picpoul de Pinet (Coteaux du Languedoc, France)

£30.95

Exuberantly fresh on the palate with ripe mango fruit, a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality - a brilliant match of the right local grape on the right terroir

## 20. Chateau Millet Graves Blanc (Bordeaux, France)

£33.50

Silky, rich mouth, the aromas are carried by a persistent freshness. Very balanced, elegant, refined whole. A pure, clean, aromatic style

## 21. Muscadet Sever et Main Sur Lie, Vieilles Vignes, Briaudiere (Loire, France)

£28.50

Flinty, lightly mineral with apple fruit and real texture and interest. The old vine fruit adds amazing depth and mineral complexity

## 22. Circumstance Sauvignon Blanc (Stellenbosch, South Africa)

£33.50

Circumstance Sauvignon Blanc is often described as The Pouilly Fumé of Stellenbosch. Stunning! Rich and minerally, showing even a slight rocky quality about it

## 23. d'A Reserve Viognier (Vin de Pays d'Oc, France)

£29.95

Complex and intense with aromas of apricot, white peach, pear, and honey. The mouth-feel is very rich with a long lasting finish

## 24. Allan Scott Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, New Zealand)

£35.50

It's intensely aromatic and instantly appealing on the nose showing grapefruit, Granny Smith apple, nectarine and lime peel aromas, leading to a concentrated palate that's lively and flavoursome

## 25. Zagare Vermentino (Sicily, Italy)

£29.00

Delicate stone fruit aromas with zesty lemon and floral notes. The palate has bright citrus peel and peach characters, an appealing texture and minerality, fresh acidity and a gently savoury finish

## 26. Chablis Domaine de la Motte (Burgundy, France)

£39.95

This Chablis has a flinty nose with ripe notes of citrus fruits. The acidity is well balanced and the flavours of orange zest are underpinned with lemon and mineral notes

# WHITE WINES

**27. Rag & Bone Riesling (Eden Valley, South Australia) £35.95**

The nose classically expresses the vineyard... it's like having a fresh lime in your hand that you crush gently over minerals... literally lime on the rocks!! The palate is bright, zingy, singing with natural acidity and really textural

**28. Sancerre, Langlois Chateau (Loire, France) £39.95**

Light yellow colour with green reflections. Very aromatic nose, on white fruits and citrus fruits. On the palate, very good balance and freshness, highlighted by the aromatic side on citrus fruits.

**29. Coste del Molino Verdicchio Classico (Marche, Italy) £31.50**

The palate is fresh and fruity; very approachable, with apple, pear and ripe stone fruit. A mouthfilling minerality adds to the complexity and palate weight

**30. Pouilly Fuisse Les Vieux Murs, Jean Loron (Burgundy, France) £49.95**

A powerful wine, with an intense palate of ripe fruit and vanilla notes and balancing acidity, leading to a long complex finish

**31. Pirueta Albarino (Rias Baixas, Spain) £32.50**

Citrus and floral aromas, with a touch of stone fruit. The palette displays a mouth-filling fruity character perfectly balanced with the vibrant zingy acidity

**32. Macon Villages La Crochette, Jean Loron (Burgundy, France) £37.50**

Delicate floral fragrances mixed with honey on a mineral note. Well balanced. Good acidity and subtle minerality

**33. Jaffelin Chardonnay (Vin de Pays d'Oc, France) £29.50**

Aromas of exotic fruits, white flowers and citrus, rounded well balanced deliciously appealing

**34. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, New Zealand) £49.50**

The definitive expression of the region and its season. Perhaps the hallmark of this vintage is its persistent finish rich with minerality

**35. Selva Lugana, Podere Selva Capuzza (Lombardia, Italy) £37.50**

Almost austere to the nose, with mineral hints that intertwine with citrus, cedar and apple. Full and complex on the palate, with a long mineral persistence

**36. Meursault Blanc, Jaffelin (Burgundy, France) £75.00**

The palate is text-book Meursault; big, big and beautiful with a long finish showing notes of grilled almonds and butter. Utterly delicious

**37. NINFA Alvarinho, Joao M Barbosa (Tejo, Portugal ) £39.00**

With a restrained nose, fresh notes of lemon peel and orange blossom stand out. In the mouth the structure and minerality are in line with the little ripe citrus fruits giving the wine a delicious complexity

**38. Saint-Véran "Les Ombrelles", Jean Loron (Beaujolais, France) £39.50**

The nose is rich, dominated by notes of yellow flowers and honey, complemented by pear and a buttered note. On the palate, intense bouquet of the nose, highlighted by a balanced structure, with roundness and a final full of freshness

# RED WINES

- 39. Hesketh Midday Somewhere Shiraz (Australia) £32.50**  
Bright red fruits of strawberry and raspberry abound on the palate. Creamy, smooth mouthfeel. Fine acid gives finesse to the palate with some hints of tobacco and spice adding savoury flavours
- 40. Château de Sales Pomerol (Bordeaux, France) £59.50**  
Aromas of black fruit, especially black cherry, violet and vanilla. Richly flavoured and remarkably well-balanced, it opens with notes of black fruit and subtle spice which fill out on an ample and complex mid-palate sustained by the caress of refined, silky tannins, leading into a long and elegant finish
- 41. Jean Gamay Noir, Jean Loron (France) £29.00**  
On the nose, it has a touch of liquorice and spice and mineral quality, with a nice maturity of blackberry and blueberry. The mouth is round with a pleasant sweetness. The balance is perfect. Jean is full of freshness and leaves us with a very soft finish
- 42. Uggiano Chianti Riserva Roccialta (Italy) £32.50**  
Aromas of black cherry, bramble fruit and hints of violet. The palate has dark, ripe plum and berry fruit with supple tannins and a long, rounded finish
- 43. Les Coteaux Cotes du Rhone, Boutinot (Rhône, France) £32.50**  
Immediately impressive this wine reveals its class from the start. Brambly fruit underpinned by subtle oaky nuances, lovely sweet spice; warm star anise with a touch of cinnamon
- 44. Nieto Don Nicanor Malbec (Argentina) £35.50**  
Dark, dense complex nose with sweet cranberries, blackberries and rich mocha characters. The palate is smooth and rounded with supple tannins and a long intense pure finish with hints of bitter chocolate and spice.
- 45. Fleurie, Chateau de Fleurie (Burgundy, France) £37.50**  
Fleurie is the "Queen" of the Beaujolais Crus. With its intense garnet red colour, it reveals irises, faded roses, ripe cherries and blackcurrant aromas. The mouth is round, fleshy and elegant
- 46. Appassimento (Puglia, Italy) £29.95**  
Rich, complex and fruity wine with notes of ripe dark cherries, fresh herbs and vanilla
- 47. Casal da Coelheira Tinto (Tejo, Portugal) £29.95**  
Juicy notes of red raspberry and blueberry on the nose. The palate continues with violet tones, earthy aromas and a bit of mocha. The mouthfeel is round and supple with a smooth finish
- 48. Chateau Cissac, Cru Bourgeois Haut Medoc (France) £39.95**  
Cabernet Sauvignon provides unmistakable, textbook aromas of cassis and pencil shavings and a firm, mouth-filling structure. Merlot and Petit Verdot add plumpness and complexity in what is a most elegant, classic Medoc
- 49. Domaine Jaffelin Côte de Beaune Villages (Burgundy, France) £42.50**  
A velvety palate with integrated tannins, showing notes of dark cherry and anise. Clean and enriched finish with notes of sour raspberry and charred toast, a lingering savoury finish. Quintessential Burgundy!

## RED WINES

### 50. Imperial Rioja Reserva, CVNE (Spain)

£42.50

Intense body of cherry colour with beautiful purple highlights. Attractive aroma of forest fruits, violets and liquorice with hints of Atlantic forest, clove and cigar leaves

### 51. Valpolicella Ripasso Capitel della Crosara, Montresor (Veneto, Italy)

£39.50

Made by passing the wine over the skins of the grapes used in the production of Amarone, the palate unveils an array of heady red fruit, spices and vanilla on the palate

### 52. Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Satinato (Veneto, Italy)

£53.00

Hints of coffee and chocolate on the nose with ripe crushed berry, bitter cherry and sweet plummy fruit on the palate - backed by notes of bitter chocolate. Rich and warming yet fresh and well-balanced, with supple tannins and a rich texture

### 53. Barolo Bussia, Dardi le Rose, Poderi Colla (Piemonte, Italy)

£68.95

Ripe meaty nose with hints of dried figs, leather, spice and generous ripe berry aromas. Rich plummy fruit, warm and spicy with herbal notes on the palate, good tannic structure and a level of acidity

### 54. Tommasi Bardolino (Garda, Italy)

£35.50

A very bright ruby red with delicately fruity aromas of cherries, strawberries, raspberries and hints of spices. On the palate it is dry, fresh and well-balanced, with a persistent tangy note that leaves a rich, fruity aftertaste.

### 55. Rive Barbera d'Asti Superiore (Piemonte, Italy)

£39.50

A deep ruby Barbera with vibrant aromas of black cherries and prunes with notes of chocolate and toasty oak. An abundance of wild blackberries, black cherries and a touch of spice show through on the palate, which has a rich, voluptuous texture balancing taught acidity and fine oak tannins

## ROSÉ WINES

### 56. MiMi en Provence Rosé (Provence, France)

£32.50

Layers of raspberry, strawberry jam in the nose invite you to a gorgeous, yet spicy palate. A fresh wine with great acidity for food pairing, but roundness to enjoy on its own

### 57. AIX Cotes de Provence Rose (Provence, France )

£42.50

Fragrant and well balanced, salmon pink in colour the nose is fresh and fragrant, delicate yet youthful and offers classy notes of watermelon, strawberries and flowers

### 58. Whispering Angel Rosé, Chateau d'Esclans (Provence, France)

£49.50

Enticing aromas of juicy ripe strawberry, white peach, passionfruit and lemon peel permeate the nostrils. White peach, dried mango, and white cherry all ride out on a wave of honey tinged with sage. Streaked with racy minerality and a lingering river-stone and pink grapefruit blossom aftertaste

## SPARKLING WINES

### 59. Langlois-Chateau Cremant De Loire Brut (Loire, France)

£32.50

Vibrant and racy fruit, bready yeast flavours and zesty appley freshness is accompanied by the waxed-lemon flavours of Chenin Blanc. The Chardonnay adds fruitiness and depth

### 60. Langlois-Chateau Cremant De Loire Rose (Loire, France)

£32.50

Light pink in colour and an elegant nose of red fruit. The wine displays a fresh, fruity and full-bodied palate bursting with raspberry and blackcurrant

## CHAMPAGNES

### 61. House Champagne (France)

£49.50

A classic blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, with the grapes coming from top-rated Premier and Grand Cru vineyards, this is a sophisticated Champagne with classic toasty aromas and fresh, crisp citrus and apple flavours

### 62. Louis Roederer Brut Premier (France)

£62.50

Smaller production than many of the prestige Houses, but demand is huge for this delicious, rich and yeasty blend. Packed with mouthfilling yeasty flavours with just a touch of hazelnuts, the finish is clean and zesty

### 63. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut (France)

£62.50

A stunning non vintage with great body and roundness, it never disappoints. Lingering fruity flavours of apple and pear on the palate create a fresh, harmonious and lively Champagne

### 64. Bollinger Special Cuvee Brut (France)

£64.50

This is a mighty, full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightfully pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent. Densely packed apple and pear fruits give way to a noticeably creamy, caramel-like finish

### 65. Veuve Clicquot Rosé (France)

£69.50

Perfectly balanced and combines elegance and personality. The nose is elegant and generous, with initial aromas of fresh red fruit (raspberry, wild strawberry, cherry and blackberry) leading to dried fruits and biscuit notes

### 66. Bollinger Rosé (France)

£77.50

Made from Pinot Noir with a dash each of Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier, this has fantastic depth of flavour. It's a seductive, showing flavours of summer berry fruits with a soft texture and long finish

### 67. Krug Grande Cuveé Brut (France)

£275.00

Krug only produce prestige Champagnes. Pale golden yellow, persistent mousse with nut and apple aromas. Rich, crisp, refreshing and fragrant with superb balance

### 68. Louis Roederer Cristal Brut (France)

£295.00

The jewel of the House of Louis Roederer is Cristal, created in 1876 for Tsar Alexander II. An intensely floral bouquet fragrant with almonds, hazelnuts and wild flowers is complemented by a touch of acidity to mark a finish of elegant persistence

### 69. Moscato Passito 'Palazzina' Araldica (Piemonte, Italy)

Ripe apricot and acacia honey characters on the palate with a core of homemade lemon curd running through to the long, fresh and lingering finish
